MINUTES OF 34TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ON 23RD JUNE 2007 AT THE ZON REGENCY HOTEL, JOHOR BAHRU

The Chairman, Engr. Prof. Dr. Amir Hashim bin Mohd Kassim called the meeting to order at 11.10 am.

1.0 OPENING REMARKS BY CHAIRMAN

- 1.1 The Chairman thanked all members who were present for the meeting. He noted that the turnout for the AGM this year was very good compared to recent years reflecting further commitment and support from members.

2.0 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 33RD AGM

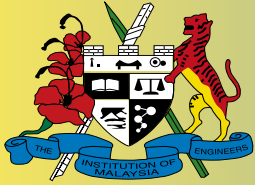
- 2.1 As there was no amendment recorded, the Minutes of 33rd AGM, proposed by Engr. Goh Kian Heng (F 05779) and seconded by Engr. Lim Soon Keng (M 07528), was confirmed as read.

3.0 MATTERS ARISING

- 3.1 No matters arising.

4.0 ANNUAL REPORT FOR SESSION 2005/2006

- 4.1 The Honorary Secretary, Engr. Mohd Khir Muhammad presented the summary of 33rd Annual Report which had been circulated earlier by mail to all members. Hon. Secretary reported on the status of membership as at December 2006 and all activities of the branch for the session 2005/2006 as per Annual Report 2005/2006 on pages 8 to 15. One of the major highlight is the setting-up of a dedicated IEM(SB) website <www.iemsb.org.my> for the purpose of dissemination of information to members.
- 4.2 Engr. Lim Soon Keng (M 07528) highlighted that there was not much activity between IEM and the local authorities. He suggested for the branch to be more proactive in liaising with the local authorities in particular on issues related to the Certificate of Completion and Compliance (CCC). He also suggested that IEM should initiate the briefing on CCC to members and for IEM to provide inputs and feedbacks on the CCC to the local authorities.
- 4.3 Engr. Vincent Chong Kin Meng (M 06829) and Engr. Ching Goo Kia (F 02329) also suggested that in view of its implementation, IEM should initiate CCC briefing to members.
- 4.4 Dato' Engr. Steve Chong Yoon On, Immediate Past Chairman agreed for IEM to be more proactive. He asked member to step forward, participate and be more involved in IEM activities.
- 4.5 Chairman informed that IEM (HQ) had initiated the program to brief members on CCC issues. The meeting was also informed that IEM and BEM would conduct briefing on CCC issues to engineers in Johor Bahru tentatively at the end of July 2007.
- 4.6 Engr. Sim Tian Liang, Vice Chairman requested members to highlight and bring forward issues related to CCC for the branch to raise with BEM.
- 4.7 Engr. John Cheah Kam Loong (F 01186) highlighted the importance for IEM to organize more activities with CPD hours for members.
- 4.8 There being no further comment or amendment, the meeting adopted the Annual Report as proposed by Engr. Puen Tak Hong (F 05558) and seconded by Engr. Chan Choong Cheong (F 02059).



5.0 FINANCIAL REPORT ENDING 31ST MARCH 2007

- 5.1 The Financial Report ending 31st March 2007 was presented by the Honorary Treasurer, Engr. Ling Ngie Soon as per pages 18 to 19 of the Annual Report.
- 5.2 Hon. Treasurer suggested that the academic awards to be extended to other categories. He also suggested that IEM programs to also include more on social, sports and other related activities as a way to contribute back to IEM members.
- 5.3 Chairman also proposed that achievement awards to outstanding members be introduced in the future.
- 5.4 Hon. Treasurer thanked internal auditors, Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee for their services for the session 2006/2007.
- 5.5 On the query from Engr. Ooi Kao Yang, (F 02331) and Engr. Prof. Mohamad Afifi Abdul Mukti (M 01793) on the status of the IEM (SB) building, Hon. Treasurer clarified that the ownership of the building is with the IEM (HQ). However, the rental income from the ground and first floors is given by the HQ to the branch as additional subsidy.
- 5.6 As there was no further clarification and amendment, the Meeting unanimously adopted the Financial Report as proposed by Engr. David Lee Hoke Hai (M 11384) and seconded by Engr. John Cheah Kam Loong (F 01186).

6.0 APPOINTMENT OF INTERNAL AUDITORS SESSION 2007/2008

- 6.1 The Chairman thanked the internal auditors, Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee for their contribution and services to audit the financial account. He then proceeded with the nomination process to elect two (2) new internal auditors for session 2007/2008.
- 6.2 Both Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee were nominated again for the two posts as proposed by Engr. John Cheah Kam Loong (F 01186) and seconded by Engr. Soh Boon Siew (M 15363).
- 6.3 Engr. Lim Soon Keng (M 07528) proposed for close of nomination and seconded by Engr. Ong Leong (M 20284).
- 6.4 There being no other nomination, both Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee were elected and confirmed as internal auditors for Session 2007/2008.

7.0 RESULT OF ELECTION FOR EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SESSION 2007/2008.

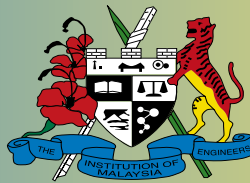
- 7.1 The result of the Executive Committee for session 2007/2008 was announced by the Election Officer Engr. Teh Sea Chuan. The results were as follows:

- 8.5 The Chairman and committee noted all issues raised by members.

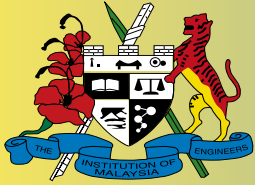
9.0 CHAIRMAN'S ADDRESS
