MINUTES OF 35TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ON 28TH JUNE 2008 AT THE ZON REGENCY HOTEL, JOHOR BAHRU

The Chairman, Engr. Prof. Dr. Amir Hashim bin Mohd Kassim called the meeting to order at 11.15 a.m.

1.0 OPENING ADDRESS BY THE CHAIRMAN FOR SESSION 2007/2008

- 1.1 The Chairman thanked all members who were present at the meeting.
- 1.2 He also welcomed and thanked the President of IEM, Dato' Paduka Engr. Hj. Keizrul Abdullah for his presence at the branch AGM this year.
- 1.3 Chairman also remarked that the turnout for the AGM of this year was very good when compared to the last few years, reflecting commitment and continuous support from members.

2.0 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 34th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- 2.1 As there was no further amendment being recorded, the Minutes of the 34th Annual General Meeting as proposed by Engr. Puen Tak Hong (F 5558) and seconded by Engr. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M 1793), was confirmed as read.

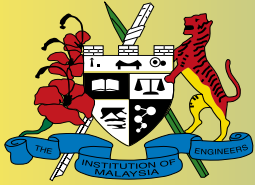
- 3.1 No matter arising.

4.0 ANNUAL REPORT FOR SESSION 2007/2008

- 4.1 The Honorary Secretary, Engr. Mohd Khir bin Muhammad presented the summary of 35th Annual Report which had been circulated earlier by mail to all members. Honorary Secretary reported on the status of membership as of December 2007 and all activities of the branch for the Session 2007/2008 as presented from page 8 to 15 of the Annual Report. The Meeting was also informed that the Branch had also donated to the Disaster Relief Fund for Myanmar & China Victims as organized by IEM(HQ).
- 4.2 There being no further comment or amendment, the meeting adopted the Annual Report as proposed by Engr. Lim Soon Keng (M 07528) and seconded by Engr. Dr. Lam Kai Yang (M 09848).

5.0 FINANCIAL REPORT ENDING 31ST MARCH 2008

- 5.1 The Financial Report ending 31st March 2008 was presented by the Honorary Treasurer, Engr. Ling Ngie Soon as per page 18 to 19 of the Annual Report.
- 5.2 Hon. Treasurer informed that the financial account statements, both current and fixed deposits, were relatively good although slightly lower profit was recorded as compared to the previous financial year. This was mainly contributed by some factors: fewer numbers of short-course being conducted; less income from rental resulted from no tenant for ground floor; and subscription to internet broadband services (Streamyx).
- 5.3 The Meeting was also informed that more CPD related activities were being organized for members for the session.
- 5.4 Hon. Treasurer thanked the internal auditors, Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee for their services for the session 2007/2008.
- 5.5 Engr. Prof. Mohamad Afifi proposed for the Branch to donate to the Building Fund of IEM (HQ). As there was no objection from the floor, the meeting agreed for the branch Committee to proceed with the donation. The amount to be decided by the Committee.
- 5.6 As there was no further clarification and amendment, the Meeting unanimously adopted the Financial Report as proposed by Engr. Lim Soon Keng (M 07528) and seconded by Engr. Geoffrey Wong Ngie Sing (M 15184).



6.0 ELECTION OF INTERNAL AUDITORS FOR SESSION 2008/2009

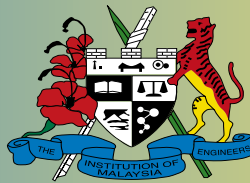
- 6.1 The Chairman thanked the internal auditors, Engr. Goh Kian Heng (F 05779) and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee (M 05701) for their contribution and services as internal auditors for Session 2007/2008. He then proceeded with the nomination process to elect two (2) new internal auditors for session 2008/2009.
- 6.2 Proposed by Engr. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M 01793) and seconded by Engr. Puen Tak Hong (F 05558), both Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee were nominated again for the posts.
- 6.3 There being no other further nominations, both Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee were elected and confirmed as internal auditors for Session 2008/2009.

7.0 RESULT OF ELECTION FOR EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SESSION 2008/2009

- 7.1 The result of the election of the Executive Committee for Session 2008/2009 was announced by the Election Officer, Engr. Teh Sea Chuan. The results were as follows:
 - 7.1.1 **Chairman**
In accordance with Section 9 and 13 of the Branch Bylaws and Regulations, Engr. Sim Tian Liang was elected as Chairman for Session 2008/2009.
 - 7.2.2 **Vice Chairman (1 vacancy for 2 Sessions – 2008/2009 and 2009/2010)**
Engr. Ling Ngie Soon was returned unopposed to the post of Vice Chairman for the Sessions 2008/2009 and 2009/2010.
 - 7.2.3 **Hon. Secretary (1 vacancy for Session 2008/2009)**
Engr. Mohd Khir bin Muhammad was returned unopposed to the post of Hon. Secretary for the Session 2008/2009.
 - 7.2.4 **Hon. Treasurer (1 vacancy for Session 2008/2009)**
Engr. Assoc. Prof. Engr. Hayati bte Abdullah was returned unopposed to the post of Hon. Treasurer for the Session 2008/2009.
 - 7.2.5 **General Committee Members (2 vacancies for 2 Sessions – 2008/2009 and 2009/2010)**
There were five (5) nominations received of which three (3) were considered as invalid and were disqualified, and therefore the two (2) valid nominations for candidates Engr. Assoc. Prof. Shuhaimi bin Mansor (M 14018) and Engr. Hj. Zainuddin bin Md Ghazali (M 04945) were returned unopposed to the post of General Committee Member for Sessions 2008/2009 and 2009/2010.
- 7.2 The Meeting recorded appreciation to Engr. Teh Sea Chuan, Engr. Koh Thong How and Engr. Lee Meng Chiat for their services and contributions in the branch election process.

8.0 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

- 8.1 The Meeting was informed that IEM had highlighted to BEM for senior engineers to be given reduction or exemption on CPD Hour requirements.
- 8.2 Engr. Lim Soon Keng (M 07528) suggested for IEM to play more active roles with the local authorities on the implementation of CCC. It was highlighted that after the last dialogue on CCC, there was not much updates for the members on CCC.
- 8.3 Engr. Prof. Dato' Alias Mohd Noor (F 04522) suggested for student and graduate members to be involved and to organize joint activities with engineering student societies of local university. Activities such as educational and technical visits to overseas could be beneficial and would provide good international exposures to IEM members, in particular to the young engineers. Universities may be able to provide funds for suitable programs.
- 8.4 Engr. Dato' Steve Chong Yoon On (F 03974) commented on the increased cost in construction activities. He urged engineers to be more vigorous with the design and to be innovative.



- 8.5 Engr. Chan Choong Cheong (F 02059) concurred with Engr. Dato' Steve on the issue of rising construction costs. He also urged engineers to be innovative and to propose new technology methods as well as ways to reduce construction cost to developers and clients.
- 8.6 Engr. Lim Soon Keng (M 07528) suggested for the engineering institutions and associations to play more active roles in overcoming the problems facing in the construction industry.
- 8.7 Engr. Dr. Lam Kai Yang (M 09848) emphasized on the use of Precast Technology, in particular for steel structures, in line with the government's effort in promotion IBS.
- 8.8 Chairman, Engr. Prof. Amir Hashim highlighted on the need for IEM to assist universities in equipping the graduates with the competency and capability of working in a global environment.
- 8.9 The committee noted all issues raised by members for further action.
- 8.10 The Chairman, Engr. Prof. Dr. Amir Hashim then handed over the Meeting to the incoming Chairman for Session 2008/2009, Engr. Sim Tian Liang. Engr. Prof. Dr. Amir Hashim thanked all committees and members for their supports during his chairmanship.

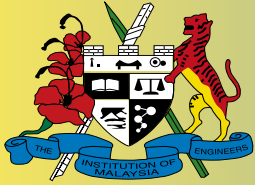
9.0 CHAIRMAN'S ADDRESS FOR SESSION 2008/2009

- 9.1 Prior to Chairman's address, Engr. Sim Tian Liang invited IEM President, Dato' Paduka Engr. Hj. Keizrul Abdullah to say a few words to the floor.
- 9.2 Dato' Paduka Engr. Hj. Keizrul thanked the Southern Branch for inviting him to the AGM and for giving him with the opportunity to address the members. He also congratulated the branch for successful conduct of the AGM.
- 9.3 Issues highlighted by the President in his speech are summarized as follows:
 - 9.3.1 President appealed for the branch to donate to the fund of IEM new building.
 - 9.3.2 He urged for the branch to be more involved and visible especially on local issues.
 - 9.3.3 He mentioned that CPD requirement was not only for engineering professional but as a global requirement for many professional bodies.
 - 9.3.4 BEM may consider reduction or exemption in the CPD hours requirement for very senior engineers.
 - 9.3.5 IEM has placed full efforts to ensure compliance to the Washington Accord signatories.
 - 9.3.6 IEM HQ was upgrading the IT systems to ensure effective service to the members – updated information on websites, change of address through the web and introduction of IEM blog site.
 - 9.3.7 Young Engineers Section (YES) was also active in their activities including overseas trips.
- 9.4 New Chairman, Engr. Sim Tian Liang (M 07463) delivered the Chairman's Address on engineering issues related to globalization.
- 9.5 As a final note, he also thanked the IEM President and all members for their presence to the AGM and hoped for their continuous support of the Institution.

The meeting was adjourned at 12.30 pm. Door gifts (IEM (Southern Branch) coffee mugs) were also distributed to all members. All members were then invited to an international buffet lunch at coffee house, Level 5 of the Zon Regency Hotel.

The Executive Committee has always maintained close relationship with the local authorities and other professional bodies in Johor.

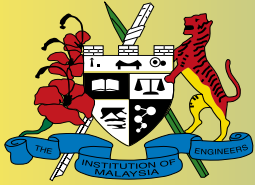

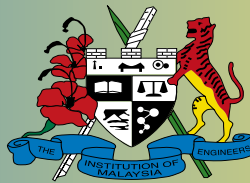
The branch, in an effort to encourage more active participation from the graduate members as well as the young engineers, has been very supportive of the Young Engineers Section (YES).
