

MINUTES OF 36TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ON 27TH JUNE 2009 AT ROOM 302, PERSADA JOHOR INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTRE, JOHOR BAHRU

The Chairman, Engr. Sim Tian Liang called the meeting to order at 11.20 a.m.

1.0 OPENING ADDRESS BY THE CHAIRMAN FOR SESSION 2008/2009

- 1.1 The Chairman thanked all members who were present at the meeting.
- 1.2 He also welcomed and thanked the President of IEM, Dato' Engr. Prof. Dr. Chuah Hean Teik for his presence at the Branch AGM this year.
- 1.3 Chairman also congratulated the President of IEM for the excellent job in promoting the engineering profession to the nation.

2.0 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 35th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- 2.1 The Minutes of the 35th Annual General Meeting as proposed by Engr. Tony Hoe Tian Hee (M 22417) and seconded by Engr. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M 1793), were confirmed after the following amendments were made:
 - 2.1.1 To include Engr. Mohan Moorthy (M 15188) in the "List of Attendees IEM (SB) 35th Annual General Meeting on 28th June 2008" on page 7.
 - 2.1.2 Correction to the numbering sequences in the "List of Attendees IEM (SB) 35th Annual General Meeting on 28th June 2008" on page 7 so that the total attendees to the 35th AGM was 123 members.

3.0 MATTERS ARISING

3.1 No matter arising.

4.0 ANNUAL REPORT FOR SESSION 2008/2009

- 4.1 The Honorary Secretary, Engr. Mohd Khir bin Muhammad presented the summary of 36th Annual Report which had been circulated earlier by mail to all members. Honorary Secretary reported on the status of membership as of June 2009 and all activities of the Branch for the Session 2008/2009 as presented from pages 8 to 15 of the Annual Report. The Meeting was also informed that the Branch had donated RM 5,000 to IEM(HQ) as well as sponsored a dinner table during IEM(HQ)'s Annual Dinner 2009; both donations were channeled to the IEM(HQ) Building Fund.
- 4.2 The Honorary Secretary informed the members of several corrections in the 35th Annual Report;
 - 4.2.1 On Page 8: Addition of the word Engr. Prof. Dr. Amir Hashim bin Mohd Kassim FIEM P.Eng.
 - 4.2.2 On Page 8: Addition of Committee Member Engr. Lee Wei Shiong MIEM P.Eng.
 - 4.2.3 On Page 9: The number of members attended during 35th Annual General Meeting shall be <u>123</u> members.



- 4.2.4 On Page 9: The name of The President of IEM shall be Y. Bhg. Dato' Paduka Engr. Hj. <u>Keizrul</u> Abdullah.
- 4.3 There being no further comment or amendment, the meeting adopted the Annual Report as proposed by Engr. Govindasamy Babu (F 6950) and seconded by Engr. Koh Thong How (M 05856).

5.0 FINANCIAL REPORT ENDING 31ST MARCH 2009

- 5.1 The Financial Report ending 31st March 2009 was presented by the Honorary Treasurer, Engr. A/Prof. Hayati bte. Abdullah as per pages 18 to 19 of the Annual Report.
- 5.2 Hon. Treasurer informed that the financial account statements, both current and fixed deposits, were higher as compared to the previous financial year. This was mainly contributed by the following factors: the Branch conducted numerous CPD Programs/Seminars and from the Members Dinner/Souvenior Programme.
- 5.3 Hon. Treasurer thanked the internal auditors, Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee for their services rendered during the session 2008/2009.
- 5.4 Engr. Quek Swee Kim (M 5009) raised the following questions to the Hon. Treasurer and the Hon. Treasurer/Chairman/Hon. Secretary subsequently replied as follows:
 - 5.4.1 <u>Question:</u> Engr. Quek inquired whether the Institution is required to pay any service tax as the Institution collected a lot of revenue from CPD Programs/Seminars.

<u>Answer:</u> Hon. Treasurer explained that the revenues collected from members, for the CPD Programs/Seminars, are not subjected to service tax. The Hon. Treasurer added that the Institution has engaged an accountant/tax agent to go through the Institution's accounts, for proper accounting in compliance with the IRB/Custom requirements.

5.4.2 <u>Question:</u> Engr. Quek highlighted that the Institution's subsidy from IEM(HQ) has reduced and wishes to inquire IEM(HQ)'s criteria in determining the subsidy amount.

<u>Answer:</u> Hon. Treasurer informed Engr. Quek that the subsidy is categorized into two (2) parts; one part is for the Branch's secretariat while the other part is dependent on the number of paying members in the Branch.

5.4.3 <u>Question:</u> Engr. Quek inquired why the drop in the number of Affiliates.

<u>Answer:</u> Hon. Secretary explained that an Affiliate Member is a person who has had the necessary experience in a responsible position in engineering or a person who by his connection with engineering science or the arts or otherwise is qualified to contribute in the advancement of engineering knowledge and his practical training, complies with the relevant Bylaws and Regulations. It may be contributed by the movement/transfer of the Affiliates' residence to other IEM Branches. It was further clarified that Affiliate referred to an individual member and not organizational membership as per understanding of Engr. Quek.

- 5.5 Engr. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M 1793) raised the following question to the Hon. Treasurer and the Hon. Treasurer/Chairman/Hon. Secretary subsequently replied as follows:
 - 5.5.1 <u>Question:</u> Engr. Afifi inquired that the "income from rental of the building" is not found in the Income and Expenditure Account.

<u>Answer:</u> Hon. Treasurer clarified that this item is located under "ADD: OTHER OPERATING INCOME – Rental".

- 5.6 Engr. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M 1793) proposed for the Branch to continue to donate RM5,000 to the Building Fund of IEM(HQ) as well as to put aside RM3,000 for future disaster funds. As there was no objection from the floor, the meeting agreed in principle for the branch Committee to proceed with the donation, subject to overall financial standing of the branch, in which the Branch Committee has to use its discretion.
- 5.7 Engr. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M 1793) also requested the Branch to reduce the CPD Programs/Seminars' commitment fees for retired Professional Engineers. The Chairman explained to Engr. Afifi that majority of the commitment fees is for the venue charges, printing charges, refreshment charges etc. He added that if corporate companies such as BlueScope Steel (M) Sdn Bhd did not sponsor these CPD Programs/Seminars, the Branch would need to charge the members even more than the current range of commitment fees.



- 5.8 Engr. Puen Tak Hong (F 5558) suggested that as the Branch has a large surplus for the current Financial Year, the Branch should award monetary incentives such as paid holiday trip for the secretariat staff, Ms Azlina Abdullah, in appreciation for her devotion and commitment to the Branch.
- 5.9 As there was no further clarification and amendment, the Meeting unanimously adopted the Financial Report as proposed by Dato' Engr. Prof. Dr. Alias b. Mohd Noor (F 4522) and seconded by Engr. Puen Tak Hong (F 5558).

6.0 ELECTION OF INTERNAL AUDITORS FOR SESSION 2009/2010

- 6.1 The Chairman thanked the internal auditors, Engr. Goh Kian Heng (F 05779) and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee (M 05701) for their contribution and services as Internal Auditors for Session 2008/2009. He then proceeded with the nomination process to elect two (2) new internal auditors for session 2009/2010.
- 6.2 Proposed by Engr. David Lee Hoke Hai (M 11384) and seconded by Dato' Engr. Chong Yoon On, Steve (F 3974), both Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee were nominated again for the posts.
- 6.3 There being no other further nominations, both Engr. Goh Kian Heng and Engr. Teo Ki Yuee were elected and confirmed as internal auditors for Session 2009/2010.

7.0 RESULT OF ELECTION FOR EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SESSION 2009/2010

- 7.1 The result of the Executive Committee for Session 2009/2010 was announced by the Election Officer, Engr. Teh Sea Chuan. The results were as follows:
 - 7.1.1 Chairman

In accordance with Section 9 and 13 of the Branch Bylaws and Regulations, the Executive Committee meeting held on 19 November 2008 unanimously re-elected the current Chairman, Engr. Sim Tian Liang as Chairman for Session 2009/2010.

7.2.2 Vice Chairman (1 vacancy for 2 Sessions - 2009/2010 and 2010/2011)

Engr. Mohd Khir Muhammad was returned unopposed to the post of Vice Chairman for the Sessions 2009/2010 and 2010/2011.

7.2.3 Hon. Secretary (1 vacancy for Session 2009/2010)

Engr. Tony Hoe Tian Hee was returned unopposed to the post of Hon. Secretary for the Session 2009/2010.

7.2.4 Hon. Treasurer (1 vacancy for Session 2009/2010)

Engr. Assoc. Prof. Engr. Hayati bte. Abdullah was returned unopposed to the post of Hon. Treasurer for the Session 2009/2010.

7.2.5 General Committee Members (2 vacancies for 2 Sessions - 2009/2010 and 2010/2011)

The ballot to fill the vacancies of the General Committee Members was conducted, as there were more nominations than the available two (2) vacancies of the General Committee Members. Engr. David Lee Hoke Hai (M 11384) and Engr. Mohd. Salehuddin bin Abdul Hamid (M 15009) were duly elected on highest votes order to the posts of General Committee Member for Sessions 2009/2010 and 2010/2011.

7.2 The Meeting recorded appreciation to Engr. Teh Sea Chuan, Engr. Koh Thong How and Engr. Lee Meng Chiat for their service and contribution in the Branch's election committee.

8.0 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

8.1 Engr. Quek Swee Kim (M 5009) highlighted that many of the Professional Engineers have taken Professional Indemnity (P.I.) insurance and inquired the Branch whether the Branch could get a group P.I. insurance at a discounted rate. The Chairman clarified that the IEM(HQ) has already put in place a group P.I. insurance scheme for the members; the Chairman urged Engr. Quek to contact IEM(HQ) for more details.



- 8.2 Dato' Engr. Prof. Dr. Alias b. Mohd Noor (F 4522) thanked the secretariat staff, Puan Lina for her good job done thus far. However, due to the increase of workload and paper works, Engr. Alias suggested to the Branch to hire a helper/assistance for Puan Lina. The Chairman replied that the Branch is currently looking for suitable candidate as the secretariat's assistant.
- 8.3 Engr. Yap Ten Leong (F 3499) requested all members not to engage price cut wars between professional engineers as this will undermine the professionalism of the Engineers.
- 8.4 The committee noted all issues raised by the members.
- 8.5 The Chairman, Engr. Sim Tian Liang thanked all committees and members for their supports during his Chairmanship and proceeded with the dissolution of the current Executive Committee for Session 2008/2009. Then, the Chairman invited the new Executive Committee for Session 2009/2010 to the stage.

9.0 CHAIRMAN'S ADDRESS FOR SESSION 2009/2010

- 9.1 Prior to Chairman's address, Engr. Sim Tian Liang invited IEM President, Dato' Engr. Prof. Dr. Chuah Hean Teik to say a few words to the floor.
- 9.2 Dato' Engr. Prof. Dr. Chuah Hean Teik thanked the Southern Branch for inviting him to the AGM and for giving him with the opportunity to address the members. He also congratulated the Branch for the successful conduct of the AGM.
- 9.3 Issues highlighted by the President in his speech are summarized as follows:
 - 9.3.1 The President highlighted that it is the Branches that are the backbone of IEM(HQ) in reaching out to the members.
 - 9.3.2 The President is pleased to see that there was a good mixture of existing members as well as young engineers in the AGM. He added that this is important for the future succession of the Institution and the Branch.
 - 9.3.3 The President, clarifying further to a question raised by Engr. Quek Swee Kim (M 5009), informed the members that IEM(HQ) has now commenced the practice of calculation branches' subsidies twice a year, compared to only once a year previously. By doing so, IEM(HQ) will accurately capture the subscription paid by the members and adjust the Branch's subsidies accordingly.
 - 9.3.4 The President is pleased to inform the members that IEM been awarded as a Full Member to the Washington Accord. He added that with this latest international recognition, the members will now be able to work as a Professional Engineer in the countries who are signatories of the Washington Accord.
- 9.4 The new Chairman, Engr. Sim Tian Liang (M 07463) delivered the Chairman's Address on "Blue Ocean Strategy for Engineering Industries".
- 9.5 As a final note, he thanked the IEM President, past chairmen and all members for their presence to the AGM and hoped for their continuous support of the Institution.

The meeting was adjourned at 1.00 pm. Door gifts, in the form of the IEM (Southern Branch)'s coffee mugs, were distributed to all members as a token of appreciation. All members were then invited to a buffet lunch at the Newsroom Cafe of the Puteri Pacific Hotel, Johor Bahru.
