1.0 Opening Address by the Chairman for Session 2022/2023

- 1.1 The Chairman, Ir. Thayala R. Selvaduray (M03717) called the meeting to order at 11.00 a.m. He extended his gratitude to all members who were present in the meeting.
- 1.2 He welcomed the Deputy President of IEM, Ir. Prof. Dr. Jeffrey Chiang Choong Luin (F20286), and expressed appreciation to the Past Chairmen of IEM (Southern Branch) who were present to support and contribute to the Southern Branch throughout his first term as Chairman.
- 1.3 The Chairman informed that 2023 marked the first year IEM (Southern Branch) organized the physical AGM after 2 years of being held in hybrid mode. He added that the activities of IEM have returned to normal.
- 1.4 The Chairman highlighted the following items as below:
 - 1.4.1 The Chairman has shared the notable IEM (Southern Branch) events for the year 2023 and major events highlights for the year 2022.
 - 1.4.2 The Chairman mentioned that throughout his chairmanship, he observed a strong collaboration between IEM and government agencies as well as societies.
 - 1.4.3 The Chairman also informed that IEM has arranged the courtesy visit to Johor Menteri Besar. The IEM President, Ir. Dr. Norlida Buniyamin had approached Menteri Besar Johor to acquire a piece of land for IEM (Southern Branch) for the development of an engineering hub and to establish a Training Centre for Engineering Technologists and Engineering Technicians.

2.0 Confirmation of Minutes of the 49th Annual General Meeting

2.1 Minutes of the 49th Annual General Meeting IEM (Southern Branch) was confirmed as proposed by Ir. Puen Tak Hong (F05558) and seconded by Ir. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M01793).

3.0 Matters Arising

- 3.1 The Chairman further discussed the following items in the Minutes of the 49th Annual General Meeting.
 - 3.1.1 Ir. Chong Woei Heng (M22025) queried on Item 5.2 where there was a discrepancy of membership grade of Ir. Quek Swee Kim. It is noted that the grade shown was not consistent with the List of Attendance. Chairman clarified that the grade is supposed to be Member, not Fellow, and it was due to a typographical error.



4.0 Annual Report for Session 2022/2023

- 4.1 The Honorary Secretary, Ir. Kamisan Turiman (M21660) presented the summary of the 49th Annual Report. Ir. Kamisan proceeded to present the Branch Activities for Session 2022/2023 as per pages 13 to 34 of the Annual Report.
- 4.2 The meeting accepted the Annual Report as proposed by Ir. Teo Kiyuee (F05701) and seconded by Ir. Chan Choong Cheong (F02059).

5.0 Statement of Financial Accounts Ending 31st December 2022

- 5.1 The Financial Report starting from 1st January 2022 ending 31st December 2022 was presented by the Honorary Treasurer, Ir. Nguee Chin Seng (M64850) as per pages 36 to 37 of the Annual Report.
- 5.2 The following were raised by the members to the Executive Committee, and the Chairman/Vice Chairman/ Hon. Treasurer/Committee Members replied as follows:
 - 5.2.1 Raised by Ir. Quek Swee Kim (M05009):

Question: Ir. Quek Swee Kim (M05009) inquired about the next measures to be taken by the Executive Committee to improve the financial health of IEM (Southern Branch). Answer: Ir. Nguee Chin Seng (M64850) explained that the deficit was due to the impact of MCO period. The Southern Branch is in the recovery stage for the year 2023 and the ground floor unit of the Southern Branch building was recently rented out. Ir. Nguee added that there will be more CPD programs organized and annual dinner souvenir program advertisements will be solicited. The Chairman also added that previously the fee for online training was minimal, and he hopes that with the physical training this year, it could help boost income. The subsidy from HQ will also help boost Southern Branch finances. The Chairman also informed that Southern Branch will be celebrating its 50th Anniversary and it will also help top-up the financial. In regards to Ir. Quek Swee Kim (M05009) query, the Chairman suggested that the Hon. Treasurer to prepare a budget forecast for income and expenditure as an action plan to control, monitor, and boost the Southern Branch's finances.

5.2.2 Raised by Ir. Sim Tian Liang (M07463):

Question: Ir. Sim Tian Liang (M07463) inquired about why the depreciation is valued 5% of the revenue and what the depreciation items are.

Answer: Ms. Wang Ing Min from T.J. Wang has clarified that the depreciation is based on allocation percentage from current assets, which is 10% for air-conditioned, electrical installations, furniture, office equipment, and signboard, while the highest percentage would be for computers. Ms. Wang also added that the major item was the renovation cost and the depreciation was almost 50% (RM8,000++) of the overall depreciation value.

5.2.3 Raised by Ir. Teo Kiyuee (F05701):

Question: Ir. Teo Kiyuee (F05701) inquired about how the Southern Branch subsidized the funding to organise the Mid-Term AFEO Meeting whereby, Southern Branch has received a grant of RM 50,000.00 from the Johor Government and yet still deficit for the year 2022. Answer: The Chairman clarified that Mid-Term Meeting expenses were RM 44,584.00 and there was a balance from that grant. He added that IEM (HQ) did not subsidize the event as the Branch volunteered to host for the event. Ir. Quek Swee Kim (M05009) advised that the funds should be spent wisely. The incoming committee should plan properly to manage the funds which have been collected by the previous committee to prevent constant deficits for the upcoming year ahead.



Ir. Wong Yee Foong (M18146) added that all these years Southern Branch's finances have depended on the collection from the Southern Branch's Annual dinner souvenir programme advertisement and CPD activities. Southern Branch charges a lower fee for CPD activity and the selling of the annual dinner table so as to encourage members to join. Therefore, the revenues could not be surpassed as the amount of collection was unable to generate income

5.2.4 Raised by Dato' Ir. Ng Ah Kow (F04883):

Question: Dato' Ir. Ng Ah Kow (F04883) inquired about the Donation to the IEM Building Fund despite the financial deficit. He proposed not to donate as the account was in deficit. Answer: Ir. Wong Yee Foong (M18146) clarified that the amount was what the Southern Branch paid for IEM (HQ) Annual Dinner table and has been classified as a "Donation" due to being considered as the Branch support to IEM (HQ).

Dato' Ir. Ng Ah Kow (F04883) proposed that the account name should be changed as it could mislead members. Hon. Treasurer to take note and inform the Accountant T.J. Wang of the changes.

5.2.5 Raised by Ir. Sim Tian Liang (M07463):

Question: Ir. Sim Tian Liang (M07463) inquired about the building status of Southern Branch. Answer: IEM Deputy President, Ir. Prof. Dr. Jeffrey Chiang Choong Luin (F20286) clarified that the Southern Branch building's debt has been settled and it is Branch's responsibility to maintain the upkeep of the building. He added that IEM Building Fund is currently supported by individual contributions that can be made through IEM portal.

5.2.6 Raised by Dato' Ir. Lim Chow Hock (HF02531):

Question: Dato' Ir. Lim Chow Hock (HF02531) inquired about the term heading "Statement of Comprehensive Income" in page 36 whereby the usual term was "Profit and Loss Statement"

Answer: Ms. Wang Ing Min from T.J. Wang has clarified that it was a new term globally adopted by the International Financial Reporting and Malaysia Institute of Accountants.

5.3 As there were no other further clarifications and amendments, the meeting unanimously adopted the Financial Reports proposed by Ir. Quek Swee Kim (M05009) and seconded by Ir. Sim Tian Liang (M07463).

6.0 Election of Internal and External Auditors

- 6.1 The Chairman thanked the Internal Auditors, Ir. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M01793) and Ir. Ling Ngie Soon (F12685) for their contributions and services as Internal Auditors for Session 2022/2023. He then proceeded with the nomination process to elect two (2) new internal auditors for session 2023/2024.
- 6.2 Dato' Ir. Ng Ah Kow (F04883) proposed that the services of the current auditors Ir. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M01793) and Ir. Ling Ngie Soon (F12685) be continued and nominated as the Internal Auditors for session Session 2023/2024. This was seconded by Ir. Quek Swee Kim (M05009). Both candidates were unanimously accepted by members.
- 6.3 Ir. Chong Woei Heng (M22025) proposed that T.J. Wang continues as IEM (Southern Branch) External Auditor which was seconded by Ir. Prof. Mohamad Afifi bin Abdul Mukti (M01793). The proposal was unanimously accepted by the members.



7.0 Election Results for Executive Committee for Session 2023/2024

- 7.3 The Chairman on behalf of IEM (Southern Branch) thanked Ir. Sim Tian Liang (M07463) and the Scrutineers for their assistance in conducting the election process.

- 8.2 The Chairman welcomed the new line-up of Executive Committee Members for Session 2023/2024.

9.0 Address by the Deputy President, Session 2022/2023

- 9.1 The Chairman invited IEM Deputy President, Ir. Prof. Dr. Jeffrey Chiang Choong Luin (F20286) to give his Presidential Address to the members.
- 9.2 The Deputy President thanked the Branch and congratulated the branch for the successful AGM and the elected IEM (Southern Branch) Executive Committee for Session 2023/2024. He expressed his contentment with Southern Branch for celebrating its 50th anniversary this year and hopes that Southern Branch may organise more events in the future.




