The seminar will guide consulting engineers, contractors, and policymakers on how to design and implement OSD systems that align with evolving green certification and environmental goals. By integrating innovative design approaches and green materials, participants will learn how to achieve compliance with standards such as the Green Building Index (GBI), CIDB’s Infrastar rating, and Bursa Malaysia’s ESG requirements. These frameworks are pivotal for organizations striving to enhance their sustainability credentials, meet investor expectations, and support national efforts to combat climate change.
